VOTING PLACES

Voting places will be open for voting on Wednesday, the 24th of October, 2018, between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at:

Cartwright Merry-Makers, 600 Broadway, Cartwright, MB -- Head of Council, Ward 1, Ward 2 (West)
Mather Community Hall, 205 Second St, Mather, MB -- Head of Council, Ward 2 (East), LUD Board

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example – driver’s license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on Election Day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at Cartwright Merry-Makers, 600 Broadway, Cartwright, MB on Saturday, October 13, 2018 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance may apply in person, in writing, by email, or by fax to the Senior Election Officer at the Cartwright-Roblin Municipality, Box 9, Cartwright, MB, R0K 0L0. Email jeannine.enns@gmail.com Fax 204-529-2288

If applying in person*, a voter may apply between September 26 and October 21, 2018.

*A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application.

If applying by mail, fax, or email**, a voter may apply between July 26 and October 21, 2018.

**A voter applying by mail, fax, or email will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the Senior Election Official.
