INTERNET AWARENESS PROGRAM—THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 24TH

On Thursday, November 24th Gord Olson from the RCMP ICE Unit will be doing a presentation at our school for grades 5-12. The presentation will explore the definition of the media coined phenomenon "SEXTING" and take the audience through a scenario. The scenario will expose what sexting is, the impacts and offer options to prevent the risks associated to sexting behaviors as well as how to reduce the harm of actions already undertaken. Also being discussed: consequences of using social media, privacy on social media, etc. The history of the presentation's development is in response to noticeable and concerning increase in reports of Self/Peer online sexual exploitation.
